HOST-SITE REQUIREMENTS

- Indoor Space, approximately 40 Feet Long by 40 Feet Wide (Gymnasiums / Multi-Purpose Rooms)
 Exhibit may be modified to allow for installation in smaller spaces (Libraries / Classrooms)
- Two 15A Grounded Outlets to plug in the charging station for the batteries
- Doors that measure at least 35 Inches Wide by 82 Inches Tall
- WIFI Connectivity
- Climate-controlled (HVAC) and adequate lighting as the exhibit is not self-lit
- Designate one individual to serve as Exhibit Manager to ensure smooth operation while the Clay2Go exhibit is installed
